### A Shared Purpose

Global Alumni Relations strives to create an eco-system that inspires and motivates our community through idea generation and knowledge sharing throughout different professional stages with the following purposes:

2. To grow as individuals into role models for each other and society.
3. To make a positive impact on our surroundings.

IE Clubs should align with this vision and do their very best to foster the interests of IE, its current students and alumni to create a strong and sustainable network.

### IE Clubs are:

#### Non-denominational

- IE Clubs must be independent from any political party, public, private, civil or religious organization and they must operate in accordance with IE's ethical values as provided in its Code of Ethics. In exceptional cases, IE Alumni Clubs will be allowed to associate with other entities, and, in such a case, they must request prior authorization from Global Alumni Relations to ensure that such association complies with IE values.



#### Constituted with Clear Objectives

- Provide Alumni the opportunity to connect around topics of interest to exchange knowledge and network through the periodic organization of academic, professional, leisure and cultural activities.
- Contribute to developing a sense of belonging to the IE Community through shared IE experiences that extend beyond graduation and throughout different professional and personal phases of life. To create opportunities to make new professional and social contacts and friendships across the IE global network.
- Represent and promote the IE brand.

### Club Activities

IE Global Alumni Relations encourages club leadership the Board of Directors to organize a minimum of two activities and/or events per year to create a pro-active membership base, promote networking and relationship building. Global Alumni Relations has identified four types of events:

2. Social event.
3. Sport event.
4. Welcome and send-off cocktails for recent graduates and/or students.
