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MOTIVATIONAL LETTER TO NOMINATE YOURSELF FOR THE AWARD YOU HAVE CHOSEN.

Motivational letter to nominate yourself for the award you have chosen. One page (500 words approx.) identifying how you have contributed to the empowerment of women as well as what you would do to improve the position of women as Business Leaders.

Note: participants can only apply to one award.

NOMINATION GUIDELINES

- All applications must be submitted by February 28th 2017.
- Only admitted candidates to IE's programmes will be considered for the awards.
- Participants will be contacted in the first round for a consultation session.
- The panel of judges will select six finalists for both awards in accordance with their professional and personal merits, motivational letter and their commitment to the IE Women Initiative.
- Finalists for the award will go through a round of interviews with IE women alumni.
- The two recipients of the award will collaborate throughout their course with IE's Centre for Diversity in a joint project that furthers the Centre's mission and empowers women in the IE community.
