Your task is to explain the context, outline the actions you would request, and justify your demand.

THE DEADLINE

The deadline for submitting your online application, along with the answer to the question requested, is **May 20th, 2016**. Don't miss your chance to be part the MIR Challenge experience and differentiate yourself from other international candidates.

THE WINNER
