Few companies / law firms in Spain recruit students without an advanced level of Spanish.

Work on your level of Spanish so that you can show to the companies that you can maintain conversations in this language, attend meetings, etc. Work on it from the beginning of your stay in Madrid:

- Make the most out of your Spanish classes at IE
- Take the Spanish Business law track

Top law firms based in Spain (both Spanish firms and international firms), depending on their specific working needs **may do the exception** and hire students without a native level of Spanish. In this case scenarios, they may value other languages, past experiences, outstanding academic profile, ...).

Areas where you might find those exceptions usually are: IDR (International Dispute Resolution), Public International Law, Competition law, in-house positions for international companies.

Also, identify law firms that might have a **desk dedicated to clients from a specific country** for which you possess the language skills. For example, a **German desk** or a **French desk**
