Be a citizen or permanent resident of **Cameroon**.



Have an **exceptional academic and personal profile**.



Have been granted **admission into Misongi** before applying to IE University.



Demonstrate **social commitment** to apply skills obtained through studies at IE towards a **lasting positive impact in their country post-graduation**.



Have been admitted into a Bachelor program at IE University.



Preference will be given to candidates who can demonstrate **financial need**.

DEADLINES: April 15th 2025 for Bachelor's program that begin in Fall of 2025.

*Attention: The admissions process may take up to 4 weeks to reach a final decision. Therefore, it is recommended to begin all necessary steps at least 6 weeks before the indicated deadline. Steps 1 and 2 of the process must be initiated by the scholarship applicants. Steps 3 and 4 pertain to internal administrative.
