WHO IS THIS SCHOLARSHIP FOR?

This scholarship is open for young candidates from South Africa who have completed their undergraduate studies and wish to further their professional development through a full-time Master's program from IE University's School of Science and Technology, a top SciTech school renowned for its access to the latest tech, innovative learning methods and business aligned approach.

WHAT DOES IT COVER?

The program offers 1 scholarship per academic year that covers 100% of tuition expenses, plus a living expenses package; and is awarded based on personal and academic excellence as well as demonstrated financial need.

ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP

There is 1 scholarship available per academic year for a South African student who has been accepted into the following full-time Master's programs* offered by the IE School of Science and Technology.

*This is based on the 2024-2025 academic offer- However, FirstRand applicants will be eligible for **all** the different Master Porgrams **actively offered** by the IE School of Science and Technology **at the moment of applying**.

REQUIREMENTS TO APPLY FOR THE SCHOLARSHIP



Be a citizen and permanent resident of the **Republic of South Africa**.



Have an **exceptional academic** and **personal profile**.



Must have been admitted to a full-time master program offered by the IE School of Science and Technology.



Demonstrate **social commitent** to apply skills obtained through studies at IE towards a **lasting positive impact in their country post-graduation**.



Have an **outstanding academic record**.



Preference given to candidates who can demonstrate **financial need**.

DEADLINES: April 13th 2025 for Master programs that begin in fall of the same year.

Attention: The admissions process may take up to 4 weeks to reach a final decision. Therefore, it is recommended to begin all necessary steps at least 6 weeks before the indicated deadline. Steps 1 and 2 of the process must be initiated by the scholarship applicants. Steps 3 and 4 pertain to internal administrative.
