- Commitment to making a positive social impact.

Be a resident in one of the 13 countries where LLYC is present: Argentina, Belgium, Brazil, Chile, Colombia, Ecuador, Spain, United States, Mexico, Panama, Peru, Portugal or Dominican Republic.



A minimum of **3 years of professional experience** <u>is strongly advised</u>.



Must **have been admitted** to one of the three selected full-time master programs offered by the IE Business School.



Demonstrate **social commitment** and leadership skills.



Have an **outstanding academic record**. and **exceptional personal profile**.



Preference given to candidates who can demonstrate **financial need**.

DEADLINE: May 1st for Master programs that begin in fall of the same year.

Steps 1 and 2 of the process must be initiated by the scholarship applicants. Steps 3 and 4 pertain to internal administrative processes.
