WHAT DOES IT COVER?

Scholarships are awarded based on financial need and cover from partial up to full of tuition and living expenses (including room and board for Master's program).

ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP

The IE - Kistefos Young Talented Leaders Scholarship Program offers up to 5 scholarships per academic year. Students accepted into one of the programs listed in page 3 of this brochure, are awarded scholarships based on financial need and cover up to 100% of tuition and living expenses (living expenses package included).

REQUIREMENTS TO APPLY FOR THE SCHOLARSHIP



Be a citizen and/permanente resident of Norway.



Have an outstanding academic record with a minimum GPA of 3.5/4, 4.5/5.



Must have been **admitted** to any of the selected full-time Master programs offered by IE University* (see full list in the next page).



Can demonstrate outstanding achievements in their personal and professional lives that have had an impact on their country or community



Demonstrate an international outlook, leadership qualities and a vision to improve Norway.*



Preference given to candidates who can demonstrate financial need.

*Please note that all candidates will have to submit an essay answering to "How will the Scholarship enable you to positively impact your country after graduation?"

ABOUT THE APPLICATION PROCESS

Have been admitted to master's program at IE (IE Admissions).

Apply to the scholarship through <u>IE</u> Financial Aid.

Candidate shortlisting by the selection committee

Final selection of the scholarship recipients.

DEADLINES: June 15th for Master programs that begin in fall of the same year.

November 15th for Master programs that begin in spring of the next year.

Attention: The admissions process may take up to 4 weeks to reach a final decision. Therefore, it is recommended to begin all necessary steps at least 6 weeks before the indicated deadline. Steps 1 and 2 of the process must be initiated by the scholarship applicants. Steps 3 and 4 pertain to internal administrative processes.
