This scholarship is open to female candidates worldwide who demonstrate academic excellence, strong leadership potential, and a financial mindset.

WHAT DOES IT COVER?

The scholarship covers 100% of tuition fees for the Master in Finance at IE Business School.

ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP

REQUIREMENTS TO APPLY FOR THE SCHOLARSHIP



Be a female candidate.



Have been admitted to the Master in Finance at IE Business School.



Preference will be given to candidates who can demonstrate financial need.



Have an **outstanding academic record** with a minimum GPA of 75/100.



Demonstrate leadership, a global outlook, and commitment to positive impact after graduation.



Candidates are required to submit an essay highlighting their previous experience in finance or any impact-driven initiative and sharing their vision for driving positive change in their home country after—and thanks to—their studies at IE.

Have been admitted to the Master in Finance program at IE (IE Admissions Program)

Apply to the Scholarship through <u>IE</u> <u>Financial Aid</u>. 3

Selection Committee of candidates admitted to IE University 4

Final selection of the beneficiary of the scholarship.

DEADLINES:

- April 15th 2026 for Master's programs that begin in Fall 2026.
- September 15th 2026 for Master's programs beginning in Spring 2027.

*Attention: The admissions process may take up to 4 weeks to reach a final decision. Therefore, it is recommended to begin all necessary steps at least 6 weeks before the indicated deadline. Steps 1 and 2 of the process must be initiated by the scholarship applicants. Steps 3 and 4 pertain to internal administrative.
