This initiative offers 1 scholarship per academic year for passionate learners to pursue undergraduate studies in the humanities at the IE School of Humanities, nurturing the next generation of thinkers, creators, and global citizens inspired by the power of culture and knowledge.

Who can apply?

This scholarship program is designed to support outstanding students residing in the United States or holding U.S. nationality, who have demonstrated exceptional academic achievement and a genuine passion for the humanities. Candidates with a demonstrated social commitment and a genuine interest or connection to Spain will be highly valued.

What does it cover?

The scholarship covers up to 50% of tuition fees for the full duration of the Bachelor in Humanities or Dual Degree in Business Administration & Humanities at IE University.

ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP

The program offers 1 scholarship per academic year for the <u>Bachelor in Humanities</u> or the <u>Dual Degree in Business Administration & Humanities</u> at the IE School of Humanities.

REQUIREMENTS TO APPLY FOR THE SCHOLARSHIP



Be a citizen or permanent resident of the **United States**.



Meet the IE University admission process requirements and **have been admitted**.



Have an **exceptional academic** and **personal profile**.



Priority will be given to candidates who demonstrate greater **financial need.**

DEADLINE: March 31st 2026 for Bachelor's programs that begin in Fall of 2026.

*Attention: The admissions process may take up to 4 weeks to reach a final decision. Therefore, it is recommended to begin all necessary steps at least 6 weeks before the indicated deadline. Steps 1 and 2 of the process must be initiated by the scholarship applicants. Steps 3 and 4 pertain to internal administrative.
