This year's IEXPEERIENCE will take place at both campuses in Madrid and Segovia

Madrid

In Madrid, you will get a taste of IE University's vibrant urban Campus, which is located in the business district of the city. Madrid is the epicenter of Spanish culture, business and politics. From the historical Plaza Mayor to the unique Prado Museum, Madrid is a city brimming with culture. Madrid's combination of art, music, performance and design contribute to making Madrid one of the most beautiful capitals in Europe.

New Campus in Madrid in 2020

With a perfect location in the heart of Madrid's Financial District, our innovative and sustainable project reflects the spirit of IE University through the construction of an urban and tech-based campus. Furthermore, its ideal proximity to this

booming business district will allow our students to seamlessly interact with major corporations and businesses.

Segovia

Named a UNESCO World heritage site in 1985, Segovia is a small and friendly city with just over 55,000 residents. Segovia is renowned as a melting pot of cultural legacies, including its Gothic and Romanesque art and architecture. The city itself contains one of the best preserved Roman aqueducts on the Iberian Peninsula. Segovia's beautiful medieval campus is located 100 km from Madrid and its international airport, and only takes 25 minutes by high speed train.

Event dates arrival and departure information

Arrival and Departure information

If you are flying into Adolfo Suárez Madrid-Barajas Airport on Friday, we will personally greet and escort you to the event. There will be a bus service (exact time to be confirmed) to pick you up at your Terminal. We kindly ask you to land to Madrid before 16.00 and to send us your arrival and departure information as soon as you have bought your airline tickets.

Adolfo Suárez-Barajas International Airport in Madrid

For all participants arriving to Madrid by plane on Friday 14th February, please go to the meeting point (arrival lounge) of your Terminal (T1, T2, T3, or T4) where two Fellow students, dressed in IE University apparel, will be waiting for you and will

guide you to the bus. Please note that there will be a bus service from 12.30 to 16.00. If you miss our shuttle service, you can catch the bus route 200 that runs from terminals T1, T2, T3 and T4 at Adolfo Suárez Madrid-Barajas airport to the Avenida de América Transport Hub. Once there, you just need to walk down María de Molina street. Our campus is located at N^o. 31bis.

Other transportation

For any participants arriving on a different date or by any other method of transportation (train, car, bus, etc), let us know so that we can give you directions to get to our campus in Madrid.

Where you will stay

In Madrid, you will stay at the NH Principe de Vergara Hotel and in Segovia, at the Hotel Infanta Isabel. Housing and meals are covered by IE University

Authorizations

As soon as you confirm your attendance, we will send you a mandatory form by email, which you will have to return signed by your parents (if you are under 18) or yourself (for 18 and older).

Temperature

Spring in Spain is nice but chilly at night. You should expect the average temperature to be between 8 and 15 degrees Celsius, so make sure you pack wisely. In Segovia, the temperature can be lower—dipping down to 8 degrees at night. During the event, dress accordingly and wear comfortable shoes. Remember that the streets in Segovia are made of cobblestone, so shoes with very thin soles or high heels will make walking difficult.

Other requirements

In Spain the voltage is 220 V, in case you have a different voltage in your home country, do not forget to bring a voltage transformer for all electronic devices. Since all transportation, food and housing expenses are covered, the cash requirement is minimal and will only be needed for any additional personal expenses. All throughout the event, you will have free access to the university wi-fi network.

Insurance, allergies, special food requirements

We highly recommend that you obtain travel insurance with international medical coverage before your arrival to Spain. Please let us know if you have any special medical conditions, allergies, or food requirements. We will pass all of this information to our on-campus nurse and university cafeteria.

Code of ethics

Community rules

3.1. Respect and tolerance

As members of a highly diverse academic community, everyone must maintain an environment of respect and tolerance in every facet of their relationship with IE University: with students, with teachers and with administrative and management staff.

3.2. Harassment

Harassing another member of the IE University community (student, teacher, administrative, services or management staff) is behaviour specifically forbidden by this code. Harassment has the purpose or effect of interfering unjustifiably with the academic, professional, social or living environment of another person who belongs to the IE University community. Harassment comprises, among other things, the following behaviour:

- Persistently and deliberately degrading, intimidating or abusing another person.
- Offensive, degrading, intimidating or hostile behaviour based on race, colour, ethnicity, nationality, religion, sex, sexual orientation, age or disability.
- Verbal abuse, threat of violence, persistent calls or messages unwanted by the receiver, or the use of sexually degrading language.

In the event of a possible situation of harassment, the Ethics Committee must find out whether the behaviour constitutes unreasonable interference in the academic, professional, social or living environment of another person who is a member of the IE University community, as regards the basic values set forth in the foreword to this code and in accordance with the rules of coexistence in the IE University community.

3.3. Respect for private property

The IE University community members will respect the private property of everyone in this community, including the buildings, equipment, furniture, educational material and other facilities of the university.

3.4. False information

This code expressly prohibits providing false information to third parties in detriment to IE University's reputation and to its members.
