

IE UNIVERSITY IS A SPACE PROTECTED AGAINST SUFFOCATION BY CHOKING

In Spain, 5 people die a day due to choking. In a choking, time is of the essence. There is no time to wait for the emergency service. Therefore, recognizing the symptoms of choking and knowing how to act can mean the difference between life and death.



In a medical emergency if a victim-casually is choking commence:

- 1. Encourage the victim to cough
- 2. If the cough isn't effective, give 5 back slaps.



3. If the obstruction persist, do 5 abdominal thrusts.



- 4. If the obstruction continues, use LIFEVAC.
- Place over nose and mouth.
- 6. Push in handle.
- 7. Pull handle.









Repeat until blockage is removed.

If the victim-casualty becomes unconscious, place the victim face up. Dial 112 for help and initiate CPR.






IE Tower Auditorium Floor -4






IE Tower Dining Hall Floor -3



María de Molina 31, Dining hall.


