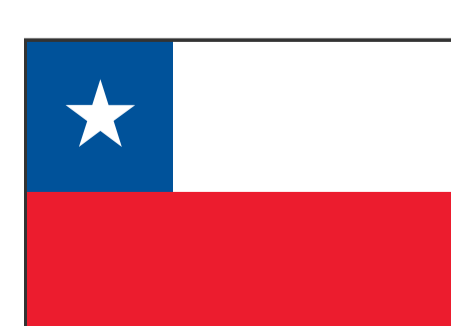
## WELCOME, HELENA!
